In times past, the Hebden Bridge Council offices building was the centre of local civic and community life. We want to make it once again the hub of our community.

Hebden Royd Partnership, the umbrella organisation for community organisations in the town, is in discussion with Calderdale Council about transferring the Hebden Bridge Council offices building into community management.

We have applied to a government programme (via the Big Lottery Fund) for capital funding, to make the building the real hub of our community. We want to bring it back to life. We want to provide a public space where different groups in the community will all feel welcome.

We want to provide facilities and opportunities for community use, including the reopening the old function hall (in recent years used as offices). This is a major need for the community: Hebden Bridge does not currently have a public hall for events and functions.

We aim to create a single access point for the delivery of public and community services, bringing

together Calderdale, the town/parish councils and voluntary and community groups.

This is a landmark building in our town, in a prominent riverside location. It has served our town for 110 years, but now needs major investment to make it ready for the next century. It also badly needs some loving care.

We know that the building has a future, not just a past. Our plans will make the building fully accessible. We are committed to using technology innovatively to create an environmentally sustainable building.
