

The Hebden Bridge Town Hall development public briefing day

Saturday July 24th

Over recent months, we have been drawing up plans for a development at the side and rear of Hebden Bridge Town Hall, to create a real civic and community hub for the town.

We anticipate our plans being presented to Calderdale for planning permission in mid July, with the planning committee decision in September or October. We are arranging a public briefing day to make it as easy as possible for you to know what we are proposing, and whether you support our plans.

The Town Hall will be open all day on July 24th, from 9.30am – 4pm. Our planning application (including the detailed plans) will be available for inspection. The architects and several of the Hebden Bridge Community Association trustees will also be present to try to answer your questions. Coffee and tea will be available.

Come at any time for the following Q&A sessions:

10.15am How we got here. And how we have tried to respond to the comments made at our public consultations.

11.00am. Going green. Making the building as energy efficient as possible.

11.45am. Design and materials. How our new building will relate to the existing Town Hall and to Hebden Bridge town centre.

12.30pm. Access and disability. Planning for a building which all will be able to use.

1.30pm. Our plans for new community facilities.

2.15pm. Transport and sustainability. Including our proposal to become a Sustainable Transport Building.

3.00pm. Our plans for local businesses. Enterprise units, facilities for home-based workers, and conference and seminar venues.
